They will present the application. They are building a 2-car garage with entrance from Flying Point Road. There are two front yards for this property since it is a corner lot and that necessitated the variance. This is set far back from the road; it is behind the house from Downs Path and the materials proposed match the existing house. R. Coburn has driven by and has no problem with the application. It is 1.6-acre corner lot. There is a letter from a

neighbor in support of the application. There is also a letter of concern, not with the garage but the desire for screening.

The survey of the property was shown. The existing attached garage is being removed to make way for a family room, so the proposed detached garage takes the place of the attached garage. R. Coburn stated the only concern would be for the neighbor with regard to setbacks but ZBA has dealt with that concern. The idea was to have the garage as low as possible, on the gradient they are sinking the garage 2-3', the height is 16' but will appear 13'. They are using existing windows and same shingle, roofing and are using the existing garage doors. On the eaves there is paneling detail to match the house. James Bracken requested adjournment to the March 9, 2020 public hearing.
